

Booking a Restaurant Dialogues

B: I look forward to having dinner at your restaurant. Thank you for your help.

A: Bennigan's Restaurant.

B: Hi, could you help me? I need to make a dinner reservation.

A: I can help you if you can just tell me what evening you like the reservation for.

B: Monday night is when we need the reservation for.

A: What time do you think that you would like to have dinner?

B: 8:00, please.

A: How many diners will be in your group?

B: We need a reservation for two.

A: I have a table for two available at 8:00, if you would just give me your name.

B: My last name is Lee. Thank you for the reservation.

A: Ms. Lee, we will be expecting you this Monday at 8:00.

B: We will be there! Thanks for the help!
