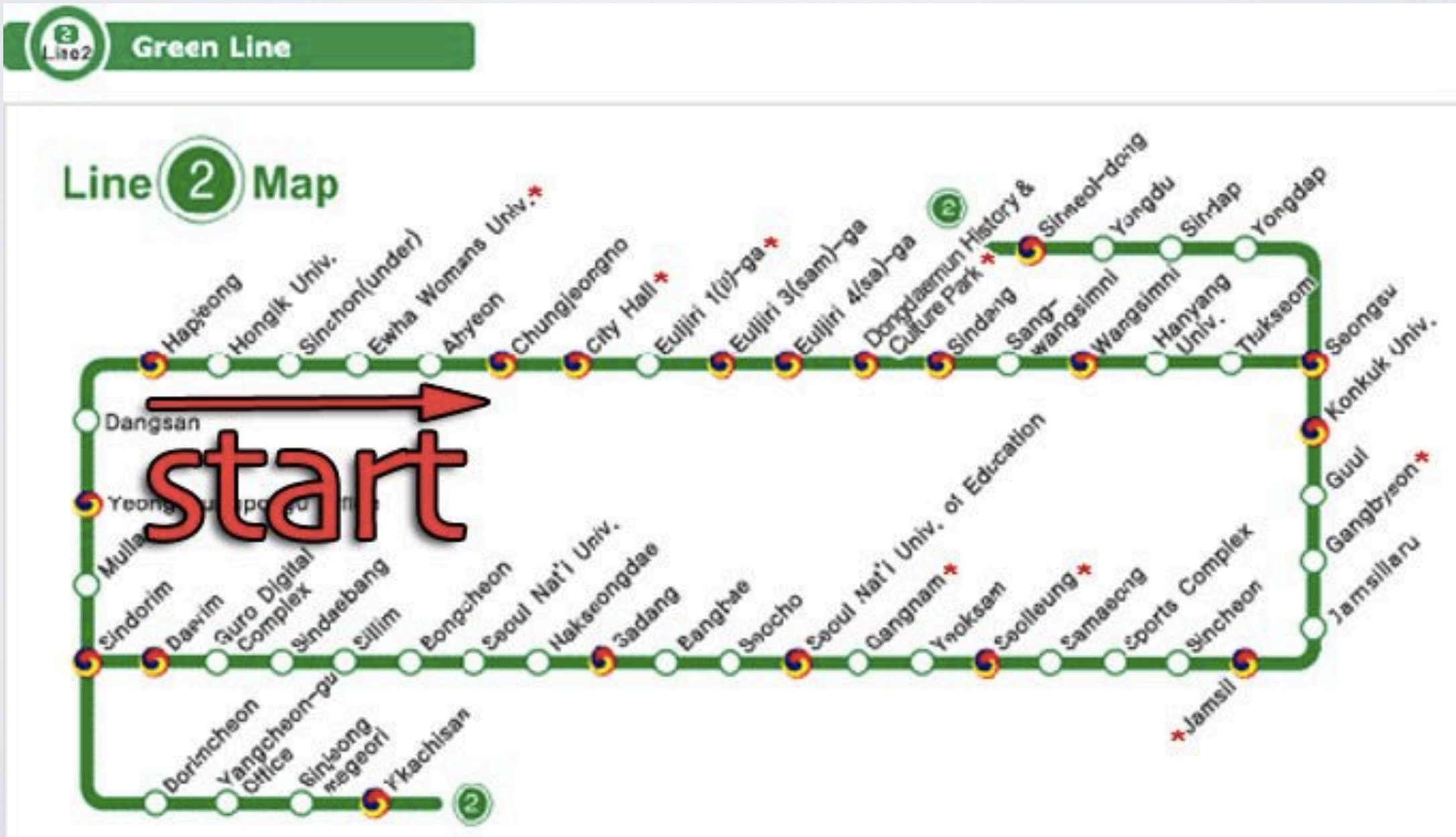

8:30am - drunk coffee

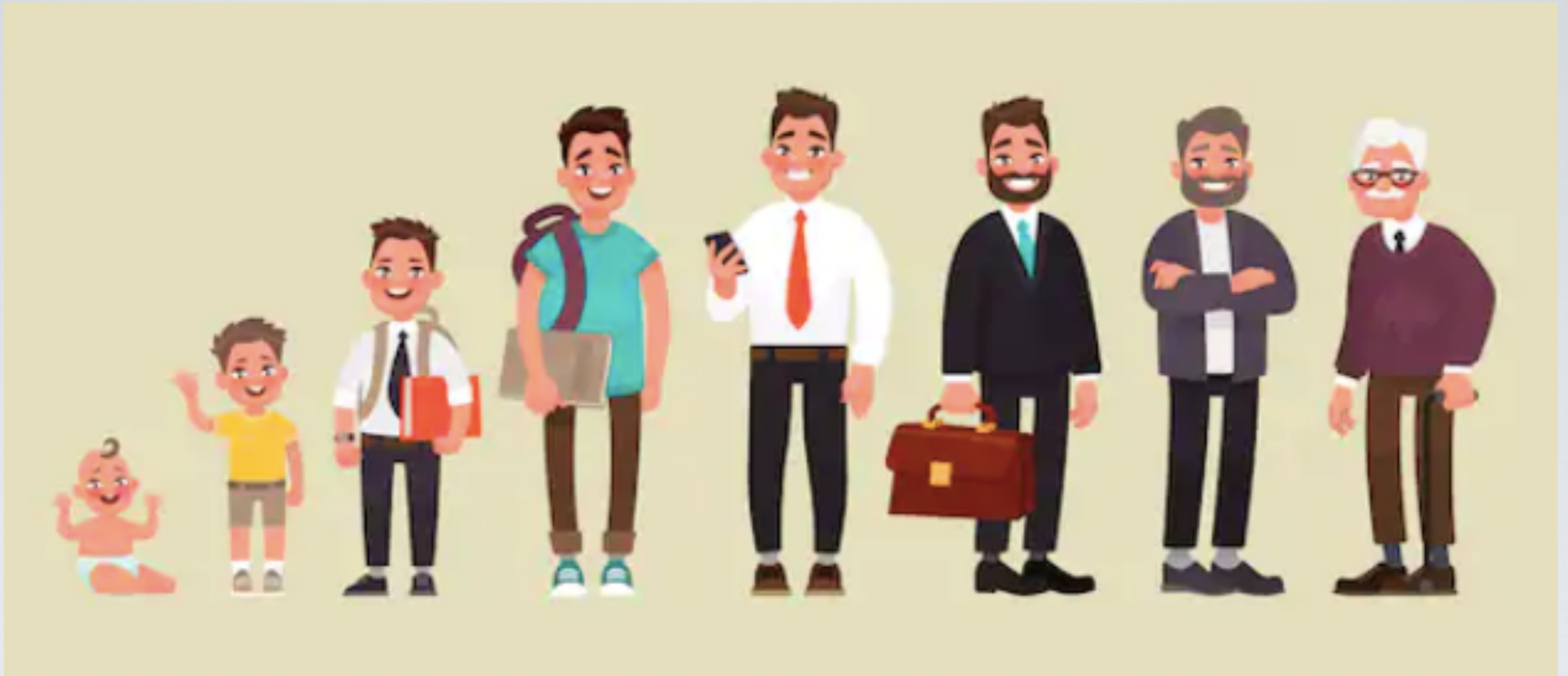
9:00am - took the subway
